## NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority is Waiuku Yacht Club, Sandspit Road, Waiuku.

### 1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

### 2.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and Supplementary Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 The Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be available online at [www.wyc.org.nz](http://www.wyc.org.nz) and on the Waiuku YC Facebook page from 13<sup>th</sup> March 2025.

### 3.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY FEE

- 3.1 The event is open to all boats of the Hartley 16 class that comply with the class rules and whose owner(s) are current financial members of the NZ H16 Class Association.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the official entry form below accompanied by payment of the entry fee by 10am on Saturday 15th March 2025.
- 3.3 The entry fee of \$80.00 may be paid by Internet banking to Waiuku Yacht Club account number 02 0476 0017633 00 (please include your name as reference).

### 4.0 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 4.1 A safety declaration is to be completed at registration and a safety check may be made on any boat at any time during the event.
- 4.2 Boats may be inspected at any time.

## 6.0 RACING AREA

6.1 The racing area is the Waiuku estuary.

## 7.0 THE COURSE

7.1 The courses will be windward – leeward, with a windward offset mark and a leeward gate.

## 8.0 SCORING

8.1 The scoring system will be the low points system.

8.2 1 race will be required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.3 When fewer than 6 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of race scores.

8.4 When 6 or more races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of race scores excluding the worst score.

## 9.0 PRIZES

9.1 Prizes will be awarded as relative to entries and sponsorship success.

## 10.0 PRIVACY WAIVER

10.1 In participating in the regatta, a competitor grants the organizing authority and the sponsors the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion any motion picture, still picture and live taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the event.

## 11.0 RISK STATEMENT

11.1 RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**
